Halloween Parade

The Annual BUMP Halloween Parade will be on Thursday, October 31st. It will kick off at 9:20 am. We will parade out the front doors and through the portico, turning left along the sidewalk and making our way across the front of the property. We ask that should you wish your child change out of their costume after the parade, please stay to help them. Teachers will not be able to change children as they are busy with the classroom activities. Each classroom will decide how to celebrate the rest of the day. In the event of rain, we will have an indoor parade route. At the end of the parade, all children will return to their classrooms, where there will be a class picture opportunity.
